Lauren Brois, Director of Energize NY's Homeowner Program, was a featured speaker at the Better Buildings Summit on May 17th in Washington D.C. as part of the session "In Concert: Orchestrating the Energy Efficiency Message."

Home energy efficiency offers a range of benefits that capture Americans' attention, which creates opportunities to engage communities on a number of fronts. Because energy efficiency serves a variety of interests and concerns, there are opportunities to forge coalitions among community groups to help expand the reach of energy efficiency campaigns. Consistent messaging and successful partnerships across public, private, and non-profit players go a long way to amplify the energy efficiency call for action.

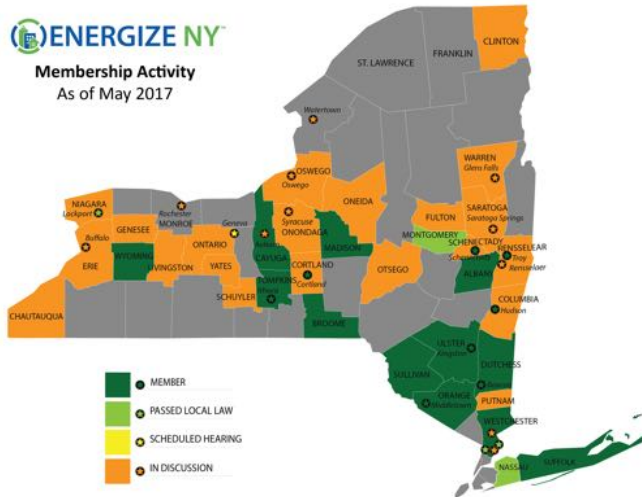
There are 3 steps for a municipality to become a member:
