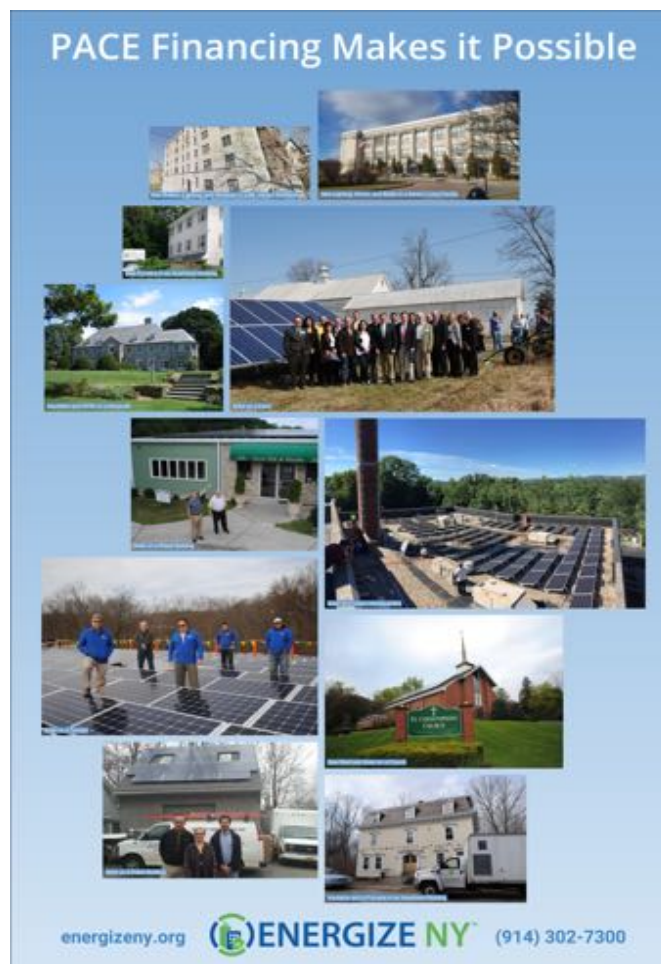

City of Geneva Passes Legislation to Join Energize NY and Offer PACE Financing

The City of Geneva, which straddles Ontario and Seneca Counties, became the 42nd municipality to pass the local law to join Energize NY and establish commercial PACE finance. The City Council unanimously passed the local law last week, joining Wyoming County, the other municipality in the Finger Lakes Region to pass PACE finance legislation. Wyoming County became a member of Energize NY in April, and the City of Geneva is expected to complete the membership process by the end of June.
